VARIETY

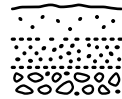
Primarily Syrah, a touch of Cinsault and Grenache.

40- to 70-year-old vines organically grown for years - parceled vineyard, surrounded by woods and garrigue, biodiversity refuge.

Limestone terraces on the high plateau and clay hillsides of Visan.



FERMENTATION

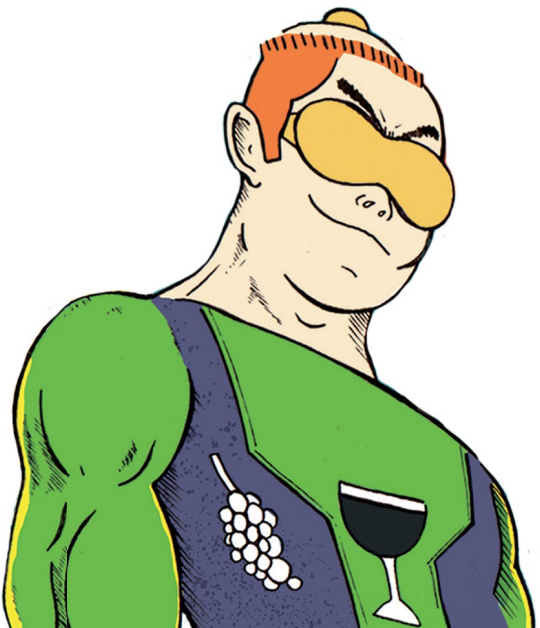
Natural. Cold pre-fermentation maceration in concrete tanks, cocotte macerations, gentle extraction.



AGING

Concrete tanks for six months, bottled on a flower day during a waning moon.

« This Visan is very savory and spicy with enough red berry fruit character to fill out the generous body and balance the quite crisp acidity. Quite a dry finish but with plenty of depth. A cuvee of grenache, syrah, mourvedre and carignan. From organically grown grapes. No sulfites added. Vegan. Drink now ».

« Striking nose of roast meat and tar. With a bit of air, spicy and leathery notes develop. Bold and dark on the full-bodied palate with an ample and firm finish. A cuvee of syrah and grenache. From organically grown grapes ».

VISAN GO GREEN

Go Green Syrah puts the emphasis on flowers and mild spices. The nose is enchanting, initially marked by pepper, cacao, and blackcurrant bud. Next come notes of raspberry and licorice.

This wine is an ode to the very generous nature of this hilltop village in the northern Vaucluse. The first impression on the palate reveals great freshness and incredible finesse. Irresistible, a real charmer. Not unlike Poison Ivy, the fatal and venomous beauty that never fails to set Batman's heart racing.
